

AUTOMOTIVE TECHNOLOGY

The Automotive Technology program offers an Associate in Applied Science Degree (A.A.S.), as well as a variety of certificates covering different automotive systems and components. The curriculum is recognized by the Automotive Service Excellence Education Foundation (ASEEF). This program is for students already working in the field or looking to get into the highly skilled trade of automotive. Courses are offered in the morning, mid-day, late afternoon, and evening; the program can be completed within four years of part-time study.

An Associate in Applied Science Degree (A.A.S.) degree is awarded to those students who, in addition to the automotive instruction courses, also complete the general education requirements and accumulate the necessary 66 semester credit hours for the degree. A certificate will be awarded to those students completing only the related automotive course instruction.

Prerequisites: High school graduation or High School Equivalency Certificate and interview with and consent of department chair.
