The goal of the Associate in Applied Science Degree in Management and Supervision is to provide students with training in the general areas of policy interpretation, goal setting, decision making, communications and motivation. The curriculum is intended to serve the needs of students who want to enter supervisory positions, and to enable those already in management to upgrade their supervisory skills and potential for growth. Cooperative work experience is incorporated in the curriculum to provide on-the-job training experience. In addition to the A.A.S. degree, three Certificate programs are offered: Leadership Excellence; Human Resource Specialist; and Organization Management.
